

Beneficiary FRS - Option 3 A reduced benefit payable for the lifetime of the retiree. Upon the death of the retiree, the joint annuitant will receive a lifetime monthly benefit in the same amount. Exception: If the date of retirement is January 1, 1996 or later and the joint annuitant, other than the spouse, is under age 25, the joint annuitant's benefit will be the retiree's Option 1 amount. This benefit is only payable until the joint annuitant reaches age 25, unless the joint annuitant is disabled and incapable of self-support, in which case the benefit continues for the duration of the disability.

FRS Home Health Insurance Subsidy (HIS) Information Help ?

F.A.Q. You are not currently receiving the Health Insurance Subsidy (HIS) benefit. If you have sent the completed Form HIS-1 and the required health insurance certification documentation to the Division of Retirement please allow 6-8 weeks to complete your request.

Forms Eligible applicants will receive the HIS benefit included with his or her monthly retirement benefit after the application has been approved. Retroactive HIS benefits, if applicable, are determined by the receipt date of all required information at the Division of Retirement.
